The district is going through its three-year audit with the Washington State Auditor's Office. The years being reviewed and 2018, 2019, and 2020. David will be supplying the Auditor's Office with needed documents to complete the audit.

Andrew Sage was able to get JMC Motorsports, Pasco to agree to bid on ATVs. This has been a struggle this year due to lack in inventory for the dealerships.

The district received its backup drone hopper from Scorpion Drone Systems for a cost of \$1,200.00.

Current Expense Vouchers:
