

**FRANKLIN COUNTY MOSQUITO CONTROL DISTRICT
BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

July 06, 2022

The regular monthly meeting of the Franklin County Mosquito Control District Board of Trustees was held on Wednesday July 06, 2022, at 12:00 pm in Pasco, WA. Those Board Members attending were John White, Stephen Boothe and Kim Empey. Also attending were Director, David Dorsett, and Field Manager, Tyler Thomas. The meeting was called to order at 12:01 pm by Board Secretary, Kim Empey. He had the Board read the June 01, 2022, meeting minutes. It was moved by John White and seconded by Stephen Boothe to accept the minutes as written. The Board voted, and the minutes were unanimously approved.

Directors Report:

The district purchased 13 cases of Natular XRT tablets from Clarke Mosquito Control Products for a cost of \$13,669.33. The additional tablets will ensure the district will be able to finish the second and final round of storm drains throughout the county.

Benton County Mosquito Control District purchased a 30-gallon drum of Dibrom adulticide from the district for a price of \$6,216.91; this was the amount paid for it in 2019.

David reported that the Yakima and Columbia rivers were close to flood levels and creating a high number of adult mosquitoes in West Pasco. Tyler has been focusing trapping and adulticiding in the area to try and reduce the number of adult biting mosquitoes.

The district assisted Leavenworth Mosquito Control District with drone treatments to areas they cannot access. Andrew Sage treated these sites on two different occasions in July.

The dual axel drone trailer had both front leaf springs break, stranding the trailer in Wenatchee. The trailer had to be hauled to Micha's Custom Works to be repaired.

Wayne Dalton replaced the district's shop garage door opener. The old opener was the original from when the building was built, and parts are no longer available.

Attorney, Christopher Kerley informed the district that there will be a partial summary judgement hearing on July 25, 2022.

Current Expense Vouchers:


David reviewed for the Board the District's June vouchers and current monthly budget, needs and purchases. The total amount of the vouchers and unpaid bills for June came to \$24,402.34 and \$75,000.00 for payroll. It was moved by Stephen Boothe to pay June's vouchers and seconded by John White. The Board voted, and the vouchers were unanimously approved.

Old/New Business:
