

**FRANKLIN COUNTY MOSQUITO CONTROL DISTRICT
BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

August 03, 2022

The regular monthly meeting of the Franklin County Mosquito Control District Board of Trustees was held on Wednesday August 03, 2022, at 12:00 pm in Pasco, WA. Those Board Members attending were John White, Stephen Boothe, Robert Hoffmann, and Kim Empey. Also attending were Director, David Dorsett, and Field Manager, Tyler Thomas. The meeting was called to order at 12:02 pm by Board President, Robert Hoffmann. He had the Board read the July 06, 2022, meeting minutes. It was moved by Stephen Boothe and seconded by John White to accept the minutes as written. The Board voted, and the minutes were unanimously approved.

Directors Report:

The district has begun receiving discounted larvicide offers. Before making any purchased David will present the offers to the Board of Trustees for review and approval. Board President, Robert Hoffmann and David attended the partial summary judgement hearing virtually at the district's office. Rulings were submitted to the court and David will keep the Board apprised of upcoming court dates. Field Manager, Tyler Thomas and the field crew have been extremely busy in July. They will continue to inspect sites and treat as needed the remainder of the mosquito season. Storm drains throughout Franklin County have been completed for the second and final time of the 2022 season. Vector Ecologist, Douglas Manukure and his assistant have been setting adult mosquito traps throughout Franklin County. They are monitor adult mosquito activity as well as testing for the presence WNV. To date there has been no positive pools detected in Franklin County. The district continues to work with Benton County Mosquito Control on completion of ongoing database projects. Finding programmers to complete these projects has been challenging. David and Tyler installed a new sign on the building. Accent Signs made the sign for a cost of \$559.81. David reviewed with the Board upcoming 2023 assessment rates and 2023 budget projections.

Current Expense Vouchers:


